

Adding Music To Your Course

Moodle makes it very easy to include music in your course.

Music excerpts are best added in 'Labels' or 'Pages' (See other InfoSheets for the basic instructions on how to create these)

As an example, this InfoSheet will demonstrate how to add music to a 'Label'.



This will open the 'Add a new Label' screen. You can now add text and images using the standard WYSIWYG editor.

You will then be given the opportunity to preview the music clip by clicking on the 'Play' icon.

If you are happy with the music clip just click on the 'Insert' button to add it to the label.

If it isn't what you were looking for you can click on 'Find or upload ...' and search again.



The music clip will just appear as a text link in the editing box.

Don't worry about this, it will display as a music clip in the label when you have finished editing it and saved it.

You can now add any text that you want to appear along with the music clip in the 'Label text' box.

When you have completed editing scroll down to the bottom of the page and click 'Save and return to course'.

The music clip will now be embedded in the course page.

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
