3. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

Main hazards: Flammable. Toxic to aquatic organisms, may cause long-term adverse effects in the aquatic

environment. Repeated exposure may cause skin dryness or cracking.

4. FIRST AID MEASURES (SYMPTOMS)

Skin contact: There may be mild irritation at the site of contact.

Eye contact: There may be irritation and redness. **Ingestion:** There may be irritation of the throat.

Inhalation: No symptoms.

4. FIRST AID MEASURES (ACTION)

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5. FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES

Clean-up procedures: Absorb into dry earth or sand. Transfer to a closable, labelled salvage container for disposal by

an appropriate method.

Storage conditions: Store in cool, well ventilated area. Keep container tightly closed. The floor of the storage room
